The Grized Ale at 4.8% has a wonderful honey center and is popular amongst those who want something a little stronger. Both are light in colour. The two other 'handpulls' feature regularly changing guest ales mostly from local micro breweries, notably those at Bargates and Coniston but others from the region do feature from time to time as do Ales from breweries nationwide as the opportunity arises.
