1. Las Montanas Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile) C £10.95

Sauvignon (Chile)

Smooth, easy drinking and packed with ripe blackcurrant flavours and a warm peppery finish.

2. Centelleo Tempranillo (Spain) C £12.95

(Spain)

Ripe, juicy, bramble and cherry fruit flavours with hints of spice. Good length and tremendous value.

3. Vina Sutil Merlot (Chile) C £13.95

(Chile)

Black cherry and bramble scented with a smooth and weighty palate.

4. Lyngrove Collection Pinotage (South Africa) C £14.95

Pinotage (South Africa)

Well balanced, medium bodied and ripe mulberry flavours with none of the characteristic 'burnt rubber' here – this is delicious wine. Try it and you will 'discover' Pinotage.

5. Cock and Bull Shiraz (Australia) C £15.50

(Australia)

This is one of a unique range and an example of the really excellent value still available in Australia to those who know where to look. An unblended Shiraz with intensity, loads of full spicy fruit and flavour, and great length.

6. Las Montanas Merlot Rosé (Chile) 2A £10.95

(Chile)

Stylish with good red berry fruit feel and soft refreshing acidity.

7. Pacific Heights Zinfandel Blush (California) 3A £11.95

Blush (California)

Stylishly packaged this is a popular medium sweet style of Blush that is bursting with succulent, scented strawberries and cream fruit flavours.

8. Las Montanas Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) 1 £10.95

Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)

Lovely, herbaceous, tropical fruit flavours with refreshing balancing acidity.

9. Nagyredé Estate Pinot Grigio (Hungary) 2 £12.95

Pinot Grigio (Hungary)

Incredibly popular, this wine is very soft and rounded. Nuances of ripe apple and honey develop lively, aromatic characteristics giving a full and crisp spicy flavour and very attractive finish.

10. Niel Joubert Chenin Blanc (South Africa) 3 £13.95

(South Africa)

A quite remarkable wine that is packed with a full rich fruit flavour. Great weight balanced with zingy acidity and a long finish.

11. Currabridge Unwooded Chardonnay (Australia) 2 £14.95

Chardonnay (Australia)

With no oak contact this wine shows very clean ripe peach and melon fruit.

12. Flying Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) 1 £15.50

(New Zealand)

Award winning winemaker Alan McCorkindale is dedicated to producing fruit-driven, fresh and vibrant wines with classic gooseberry aromas and flavours.

13. Cava Portaceli Brut NV (Spain) 1 £13.95

(Spain)

Spain's best sparklers are known as Cava. This is a soft and fruity reserva wine, and represents great value.

14. Pommery Brut Royal NV 1 £33.95

Carefully selected blend with great finesse. A round and full, yet delicate, wine that lingers on the finish and lifts the palate.
